


The Foundation Stage 2 Newsletter

Treasure

This week the children have been thinking about the scientific concept of **floating and sinking** and learning about it through exploration. They have looked at different objects in the classroom and investigated which ones would sink and which would float. They soon saw a pattern and realised that heavier/denser things would sink and lighter things would float. They also found that some things would float for a while, but would sink

once they got wet through. They used their findings to help choose the materials they would use to build their own ships out of junk.

<u>Literacy</u>

This week in **Literacy**, we have been reading the story **Captain McGrew Wants You for his Crew**. The children have listened to the story and explored it's new vocabulary, looking particularly at adjectives. We discussed the skills the children would need to be a pirate and the children had a go at writing some of the things they can do that would make them good pirates. Finally we thought about what kind of Captain, Captain McGrew is and if we would actually want to work for him.

In **Phonics**, we have continued to review all the phase 2 sounds and tricky words, with a particular focus on **d** and **b**, and **a** and **u**. We have then spent the week focused on blending sounds to read words and segmenting words for writing. We have also looked at reading and writing simple captions.

<u>Maths</u>

This week in Maths, the children have been practicing **estimation** and **addition**. We discussed the concept of estimation, and that it is making a sensible guess. The children estimated and then checked how close their estimates were by counting.

We also practiced adding two numbers together. We learnt the vocabulary of addition; **plus**, **add**, and **more**, and practiced adding. We discussed the fact that addition means taking two numbers, and putting them together, so when you add, your numbers

always get bigger. We used our fingers, counters and putting one number in our head and counting on, to find the answers. to simple addition questions.
