Fees include: text books, stationery, some art and design and all home economics materials, subscriptions for the C.C.F., compulsory visits for A-Level and GCSE, laundry for borders, The Chronicle, games and certain school entertainments and school meals (lunch and tea only for day pupils) and the OG lifetime subscription.

The following are not included in the fees: external Examination Boards (e.g. GCSE and A-levels), clothing and purchases from the School Shop, certain trips (to theatres etc), a pupil's personal expenses, some optional co-curricular activities and the following optional individual tuition:

Speech and drama lessons

Individual 30-minute lessons:	£220.00 per term
Shared 30-minute lessons:	£190.00 per term

Examination fees for speech and drama are not included in the fees above.

Music lessons

Individual 30-minute lesson:	£30.00 per lesson
Individual 20-minute lesson:	£20.00 per lesson
Mixture of Individual and shared lessons:	£25.00 per lesson

The number of lessons given in an academic year are in the region of 30, with a maximum of 33. Lessons are charged in the term they are taken so the charge will fluctuate in line with the length of the term. Half a term's notice is required to terminate individual speech and drama or music lessons.

Support lessons (including learning support and EAL tuition)

Individual 30-minute lessons: £300.00 per term.

There will be a minimum of ten lessons per term. For pupils having shared lessons, or more than one lesson per week, this sum will be adjusted pro rata.

Overnight stays by day pupils

Night rate for occasional use subject to availability:

Senior School (year 9 – U6)	£80.00 per night
Catteral (up to year 8)	£60.00 per night

In certain circumstances, at the School's discretion, there may be no charge for day pupils staying overnight.

Exeat charge

Pupils in Year 9 and above may stay at school during exeat weekends subject to prior agreement with the School.

Exeat charge for Year 9 and above: £100.00 per day

Airport transport

School transport can be provided for pupils to and from the airports at Manchester, Liverpool and Leeds/Bradford, subject to availability and pre-booking. A minimum of 48 hours' notice is required. These journeys are charged at a flat rate per trip, the cost of which is placed on the school bill. There is an additional charge made for any journey to the airport that takes place more than **24** hours before or after the published holiday dates.

Flat rate for airport transfer:	£80.00
Additional charge for airport transfer:	£40.00

It is the intention of the governors that there are no changes in fee rates throughout the year. However, Giggleswick School reserves the right to recover additional unforeseen costs, such as those resulting from a change in legislation. Should there be a need to return to remote learning then there may a requirement to adjust the fees to reflect this.
