

Directions for Linking LEA Website to Future Ready PA Index/ESSA Federal Report Button


How does the Federal statute (ESSA) specify that every LEA must disseminate its report card?

An LEA must make the annual LEA report card publicly available on the LEA's Web site. If an LEA does not operate a Website, the LEA may provide the information to the public in another manner determined by the LEA. (ESEA1111(h)(2)(B)(iii); 34 C.F.R. § 200.31(d)(2)).

Steps to Link ESSA Federal Report to LEA Website

- 1) Enter Future Ready PA Index: <https://futurereadypa.org/>
- 2) Locate School Page using one of the available Search Tools.
