Ms. Dust reviewed the budget timeline and provided an overview of each category in the 2020-2021 preliminary budget.

The Board thanked Ms. Dust for the presentation.



Superintendent Randy Liepa, spoke to the uncertainty of the budget with possible revenue shortfalls at the state level, and said administration will bring forward a budget revision if needed, based on updated revenue projections from the state. He shared we are monitoring this every day.
