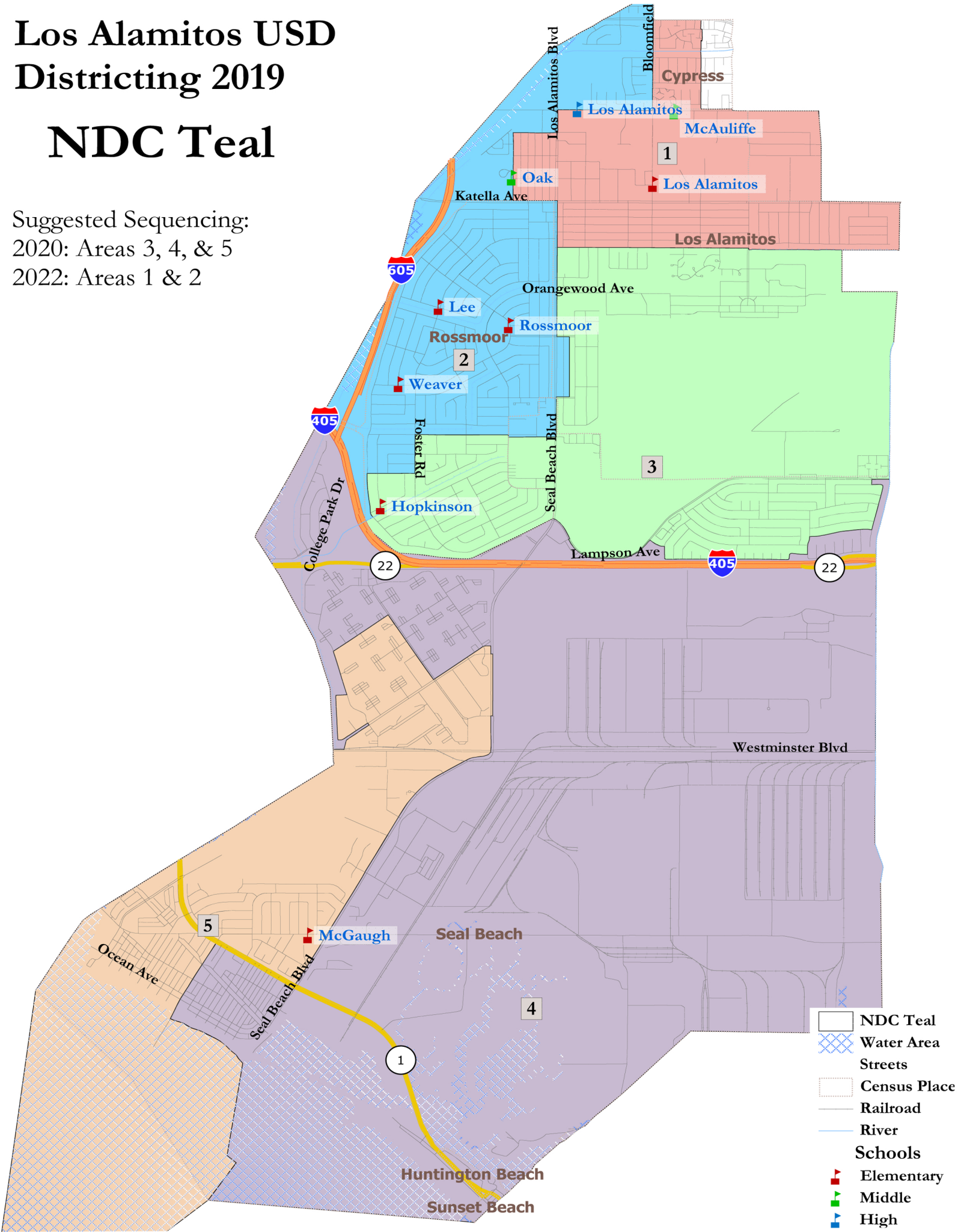


Los Alamitos USD Districting 2019

Teal Map Summary

This map divides Leisure World between Areas 4 and 5. Three areas are north of I-405, with Area 2 mostly in Rossmoor and including most of Rossmoor. Area 3 includes south Rossmoor, including Hopkinson Elementary, and most of College Park East; and Areas 4 and 5 split Seal Beach south of I-405, including linking College Park West with Surfside and other beach neighborhoods in Area 4. Trustee Davidson is in Area 1; Trustee Hill is in Area 2; Trustee Boyer is in Area 3; Trustees Cutuli and Russell are in Area 5, with Area 4 vacant.
