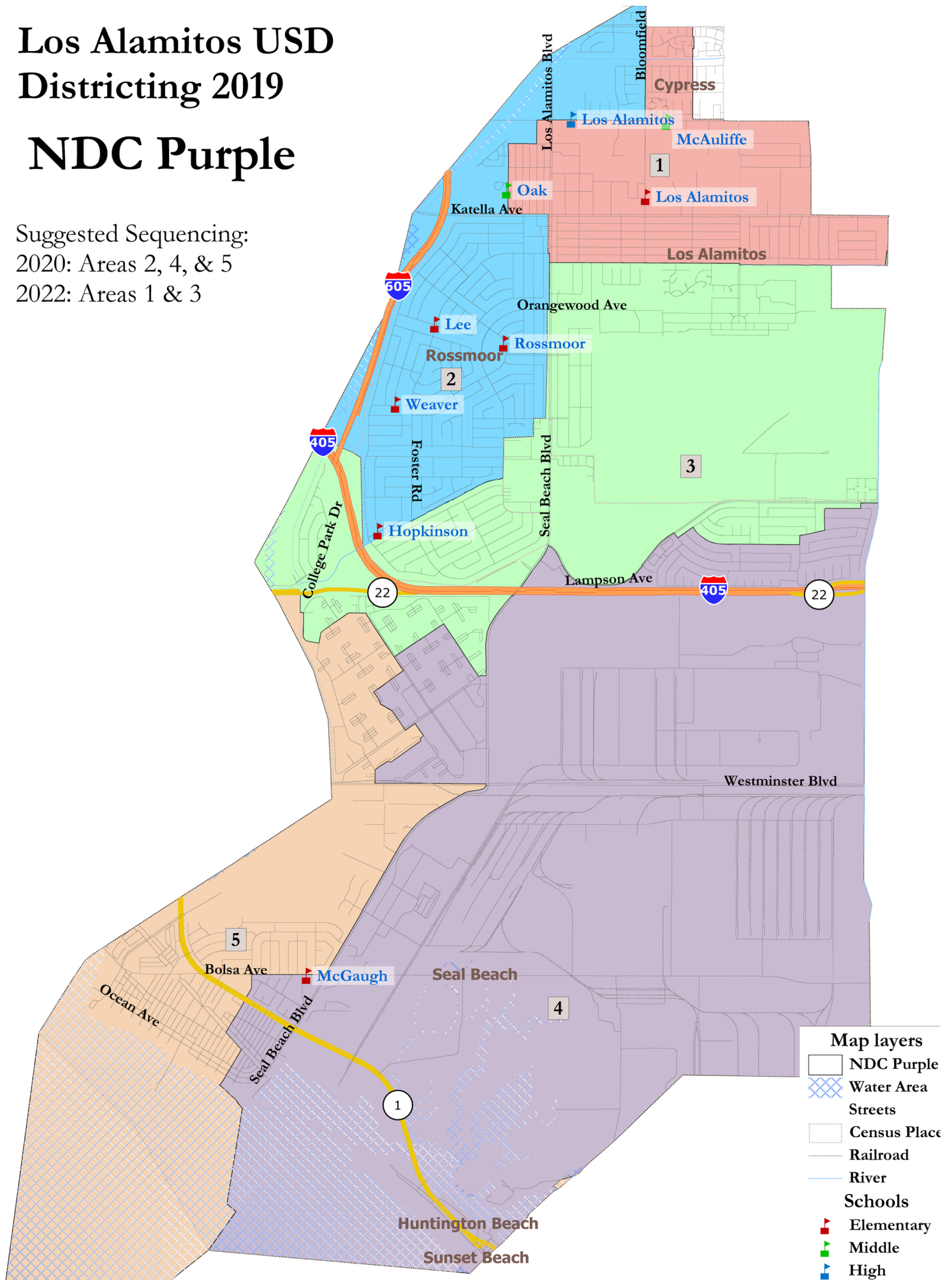


Los Alamitos USD Districting 2019

Purple Map Summary

This map divides Leisure World into three areas. It keeps Area 2 principally in Rossmoor (85%), with a small part of Los Alamitos north of Katella along I-605. Area 3 includes the remainder of Los Alamitos along with south Rossmoor and northern parts of Seal Beach on both sides of Seal Beach Boulevard. This map divides Seal Beach between Areas 4 and 5 and places McGaugh Elementary in Area 4. Trustee Davidson is in Area 1; Trustees Boyer and Hill are in Area 3; Trustee Russell is in area 4; Trustee Cutuli is in Area 5, with Area 2 vacant.
