SENIOR OFF-CAMPUS POLICY FORM

We expect seniors at Bellevue Christian School to demonstrate a certain level of maturity and responsibility. To demonstrate that we trust our seniors, our Senior Off-Campus Policy grants seniors off campus privileges under certain conditions, including lunch and Office Hours (Tuesday/Thursday). One of those conditions is parental consent. Only those students having a signed permission form on file will be allowed to leave campus. Parents should guide their child about offering or requesting rides with other students during lunch time based on insurance coverage and personal philosophy. The school is unable to supervise ride arrangements.

Students must sign out and sign in at the front desk whenever they leave campus.

SENIOR OFF CAMPUS POLICY

1. Parents, this letter serves as notification that BCS will grant off-campus privileges to seniors who have prior parental permission.
2. This permission form must be filled out, signed by the parent and returned to the high school office.
3. Any violation of Senior Off-campus Policy will result in loss of off-campus privilege. Examples include,
 - a. going off campus with underclassmen for lunch other than on long lunch,
 - b. returning late to class after lunch,
 - c. leaving campus without permission at other times,
 - d. violating the driving/parking regulations listed on the parking permit application, or
 - e. speeding through the parking lots or on surrounding streets.

THE ATTACHED FORM MUST BE SIGNED AND RETURNED TO THE FRONT OFFICE BEFORE YOUR STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE CAMPUS
