We Offer:

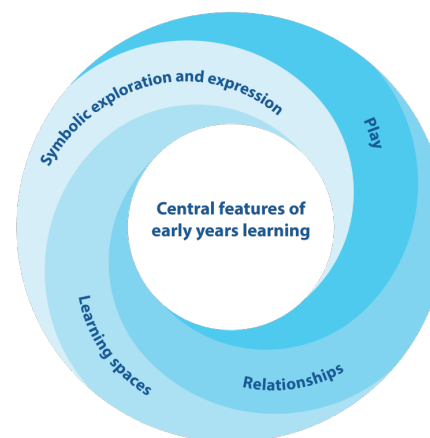
- **International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme**
Fridley Preschool is a candidate school* for the International Baccalaureate (IB) Primary Years Programme (PYP) and pursuing authorization as an IB World School. *Only schools authorized by the International Baccalaureate can offer any of its four academic programmes: the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), the Diploma Programme or the Career-related Programme (CP). Candidate status gives no guarantee that authorization will be granted.
- **IB Learner Profile**
As an IB candidate school, Fridley Preschool promotes the IB Learner Profile values. The values of the Learner Profile are: *Inquirers, Open-minded, Knowledgeable, Caring, Thinkers, Risk-Takers, Communicators, Balanced, Principled, Reflective.*

- **Caring and nurturing teachers**
Each classroom is led by a Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) licensed Early Childhood Educator. Your child will receive personalized attention as each class is capped at 20 students with a teacher and aide in each classroom.
- **Parent Aware Four-Star Rating**
Fridley Public Schools is proud to offer a 4 Star Parent Aware rated Pre-school Program to help prepare your child for school success.
- **High-quality and Aligned Curriculum**
Our preschool curriculum has been written to encompass several areas of inquiry and is aligned with Minnesota's Early Childhood Indicators of Progress (ECIPs). The ECIPs are Minnesota's early learning standards that provide a framework for developmentally appropriate expectations from birth to kindergarten. They also align to the Minnesota Kindergarten Academic Standards.

Children must be 3 years old by September 1, 2020

Cost: 9 monthly payments of \$200/mo or \$1,800 annually. A sliding fee scale, based on income, is also available.

Registration Information

To register for 3-year-old Preschool, you can either:

- **Go online**

Visit <https://fridley.ce.eleyo.com> to fill out an application. You must create an Eleyo account and profile for your child to register for Fridley Preschool, ECCE or Tiger Club Childcare.

- **Come to the Fridley Community Center**

Visit the Enrollment Center (located in the Fridley Community Center) at 6085 7th Street NE, Fridley, 55432. Staff will assist you in registering and completing the online application.

To register for 4-year-old Preschool, you can either:

- **Go online**

Visit www.fridley.k12.mn.us and choose the yellow 'Enroll' button at the top of the page. The 'Ready to Enroll' link is found at the bottom of the enrollment page.

To complete the registration process, you will need to bring the required documents (listed in the box below) to the Enrollment Center (located in the Fridley Community Center).

- **Come to the Fridley Community Center**

Visit the Enrollment Center (located in the Fridley Community Center) at 6085 7th Street NE, Fridley, 55432. Staff will assist you in completing the online registration. Please bring the required documents (listed in the box below).

Please be sure to have the following required documents with you when registering:

- Proof of address (driver's license, utility bill, rental/purchase agreement) OR Open Enrollment Form.
- Child's original birth certificate.
- Up-to-date immunization records.
- Preschool screening documents if screened outside our district.

Copies will be made of each document and originals returned to you. **Registration is not complete until we have received all of the above documents.**

Reminders! Please keep in mind that...

- **Immunizations need to be up-to-date by the first day of school**
- **Early Childhood Screening must be completed or scheduled for completion (see below)**
- **All preschool students MUST be potty-trained**

Schedule your child's Early Childhood Screening

An Early Childhood Screening is required by Minnesota State Law prior to entrance into public school. Screenings are conducted at the Fridley Community Center (6085 7th Street NE) throughout the year.
