Art

Art is integrated into the content areas of Bible, History, Math Literature and Science. Art Concepts studied include:

- Understand and apply the Elements of design- line, shape, color, texture, value, space found in God's creation
- Understand and apply the Principles of design-contrast, emphasis, balance, unity, pattern, movement and rhythm found in God's creation
- Color theory: primary colors, secondary colors, tints and shades, warm and cool
- Discuss how art tells stories about people, historical events and culture
- Compare different styles of art: realism, abstract, expressionism,
- Recognize that artists' styles change over time
- Describe and use proportion correctly in art works

- Understand positive and negative shapes
- Observe design in natural organisms
- Differentiate between 2-D and 3-D
- Identify jobs in art
