



Los AI EdTech: *Getting to know your chromebook...*

What is a chromebook?

Google describes a chromebook as a browser with a keyboard. You don't install programs (google docs, word, etc.). All resources are on the web.

Logging into the chromebook:

It is important that you student logs into the chromebook with their district issued **@GoLosAI.net account** not a free gmail account. All of their learning at school will be shared through their student @GoLosAI account. You will receive an email with your student's account username and password.

What next???

All Los AI resources are available through the student portal (myLosAI.golosal.net). Resources include:

- Google Classroom (Assignments & Messages)
- Google Drive (Document Storage)
- Google Docs (similar to Word)
- Google Slides (similar to Powerpoint)
- ST Math

- Powerpoint*

*due to the nature of google classroom, we recommend students work in google docs rather than online Microsoft apps for most assignments. This will prevent errors in saving saving and sharing work.

**Keep in mind, students can access their myLosAI account from any computer. Simply open up the web browser, go to myLosAI.golosal.net, and login. We recommend that, whether you have a PC or Mac, you install and use the Chrome Browser (go to bit.ly/losalchrome to download)

How to access the Wifi:

Students connect to the **LosAIBYOD** network at school. The password is **Whal3s!!**
