CAMP EXPECTATIONS

Students are expected to listen and be respectful of all camp staff while they are teaching classes, making announcements, giving instructions, or putting on skits. Students at CODES are expected to be on their best behavior. You are responsible for your own actions; if you cannot abide by the rules, you will be sent home.

The same rules that are enforced at school pertain to the time spent at camp. Students will receive similar consequences at camp that they would at school for breaking rules. A student can be suspended from school while at camp.

CAMP RULES

Other rules will be discussed upon arrival at camp.

- Respect other people's property. If it is not yours, do not touch it.
- You may not go into a cabin other than your own without an Instructor's permission. Girls <u>cannot</u> visit boy cabins, and boys <u>cannot</u> visit girl cabins.
- No food or drinks in cabins. Students should be good stewards of the cabins, and that includes keeping food out.
- **No technology allowed.** Phones, electronic games, and tablets are not permitted. Students can bring cameras to be used on trails or during free time. Cameras may not be used in cabins. Any device with a data plan can't be used as a camera.
- You have broken the rules if you are involved in fighting, pretend fighting, teasing, put downs, gossip, or hurting another person, even if you didn't start it.
- Show respect for nature by not littering, not picking flowers or plants, not picking up sticks or rocks, and <u>always</u> walking on the trails. Do not run unless allowed to by an Instructor.
- · Wildlife is wild and should be left alone. Please tell your Instructor if you see something, but do not touch it or chase it.
- Use the bathroom during your breaks! When you are in class, you will be outside and bathrooms will not be available. You are responsible for taking care of yourself during the breaks between each class and meal.
- You must be with an adult at all times. Do not wander off!

THREE STRIKES POLICY

STRIKE 1: The 1st strike will result in being counseled by a District Teacher.

STRIKE 2: The 2nd strike will result in a serious talk in the camp office with a District Teacher and the CODES Principal. Parents will be notified by phone of the 2nd strike and the student will be placed on a behavior contract.

STRIKE 3: The 3rd strike will result in the student being sent home immediately. Parents will be required to pick up their child immediately.

Any student that jeopardizes the safety of any other student or staff member will be immediately expelled from camp with no other warnings or chances.
