Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to be writing to you about your child's transfer to Slough and Eton in September. We are pleased to be full once again and to retain our position as a popular school in the community.

The Covid-19 pandemic means we are not able to run transition activities in the usual way. Normally, Year 6 pupils would spend a day with us in July and parents would come into school for an evening meeting where I, along with other members of staff, would take you through everything you needed to know to be ready for September. Instead of this we will be contacting all parents and inviting you into school for a meeting with your child's new Form Tutor. This person will be a key contact for your child and the person they will see every day.

Next week we will contact you by telephone to arrange your transition meeting. That meeting will be about 30 minutes long and will cover everything you need to know to be ready for September. We will collect any paperwork we are missing, complete any further forms and you will be able to order uniform. Your child's Form Tutor will give you all the information you need and you will have a chance to ask any questions. You will also be given a booklet to take home that includes activities to complete before September. Crucially, we will start to get to know your child and help them to be ready for September. We will also share with you details of the Summer School we are hoping to run from Monday 24th to Friday 28th August, which we would like all new Year 7s to attend.

We have a variety of slots available for these meetings so will be as flexible as we can be and request that, wherever possible, only one parent comes into school and that you bring your child with you. We will have appropriate social distancing measures in place and will guide you to exactly where you need to be.
