STEM HIGHLIGHTS

- STEM is a Google school which utilizes Chromebooks (including a tablet version) for students to express and share their learning. Technology is embedded into the regular classroom along with a specialist class that is provided on a regular basis.
- Extended learning opportunities are available through community partnerships, field trips and school assemblies. Partner organizations include: Wood Lake Nature Center, University of MN, Mayo Clinic, Exploradome, and Science House.
- School-wide system of support that includes English Language Learners, Newcomer Academy, Accelerated Learners, and Special Education.
- After-school activities include Future Problem Solvers, ALC (Math & Reading interventions), and regionally-competitive Lego League.
- Additional STEM spaces are used to deepen student learning. These dedicated spaces include the: science lab, WOW (engineering lab), outdoor garden, technology lab, and media center.
