### Transportation Boundaries



While families can enroll their child in any of Richfield’s four elementary programs, transportation to the two neighborhood schools—Sheridan Hills and Centennial—is determined by their home address.

Families who live west of Nicollet Avenue will get busing to Sheridan Hills and families living east of Nicollet Avenue will get busing to Centennial.

District-wide busing is available to either of the magnet schools— RDLs or STEM.
