

Victor Valley Union High School District to Victor Valley College CTE Articulated Course Credit

Memorandum of Understanding

The list of courses contained within this agreement represent the mutually agreed upon comprehensive course list between Victor Valley Community College and the Victor Valley Union High School District for academic years 2016-2017 and 2017-2018. Articulation agreement is conducted on a district to district basis and the list below is representative of the high schools that currently conduct the included courses. If during the MOU period a high school wishes to implement a district approved course articulation it must notify the Dean of Health Science Public Safety and Industrial Technology at Victor Valley College and the Director of the Mountain Desert Regional Career Occupational Pathways-JPA prior to March 1st of the academic year for which credit will be awarded.

Victor Valley Union High School District agrees to and will:

1. Ensure that each course named in the memorandum of understanding will meet the academic rigor of a college level course taught at Victor Valley College.
2. Ensure that each course meets with students at least the minimum hours for each specific class listed in the MOU as determined by Victor Valley College approved curriculum.
3. Ensure that only appropriately qualified instructors will instruct articulated courses at the secondary school site if they are to be articulated with Victor Valley College.
4. Ensure that integrity of data being submitted to the student system and data integrity shall be certified by the school site or district registrar.
5. Ensure that all students that are to receive articulated course credit must have successfully completed the K-16 Bridge My Mentor matriculation process including:
 - a. Completion of a VVC application
 - b. Linking the VVC Web advisor system to the K-16 Bridge My Mentor systemAll final grades must be submitted to the K-16 Bridge system no later than the 3rd Friday in June

Victor Valley Community College's agrees to and will:

1. Award college credit to high school students who earn an "A" or "B" in career-related, clearly identified CTE articulated high school/ROP CTE courses.
2. All grades entered in the K-16 Bridge My Mentor System shall be awarded and transcribed credit to the Victor Valley College transcript prior to the first day that incoming freshman can register for classes.
