1. Personal mask - Land's End is making one for the Basilica School, and it will be available for purchase in mid-July; the Land's End mask is not required, but a cloth mask that can be washed, reused and is appropriate for school use is required for grades 4-8
2. 1 Large Pencil Case labeled with the student's name (something similar to [this](#)) All student supplies will be held in pencil cases.
3. 3 packs of pencils (Students will only keep 5 pencils in their pencil case daily, the rest can be housed at home or in students bookbag)
4. 1 pack of colored pencils
5. 1 pack of thin markers
6. 1 pack of crayons
7. 1 4-pack of dry erase markers
8. 1 pack of glue sticks
9. 1 pair of scissor
10. 4 marble notebooks
11. 1 3-subject notebook ([example](#))
12. 4 folders (Red, Green, Blue & Yellow)
13. 2 containers of disinfectant wipes (it's OK if you cannot find these items due to our present circumstances)
14. 1 box of tissues
15. 1 pair of inexpensive earbuds to use with ipads
16. 1 6" ruler
17. 1 set of multicolored highlighters. ([Here](#) is a set that would be perfect!)
