

Student Supply List for 6th Grade 2020-2021

At all times each student must have the following, which should be **replenished** throughout the year as needed. **All** notebooks, folders, pencils, markers, etc. need to be clearly labeled with the student's name. Feel free to use a thin-tip Sharpie to write your name or make ["flags" with tape](#) or [duct tape](#).

Personal mask - Land's End is making one for the Basilica School, and it will be available for purchase in mid-July; the Land's End mask is not required, but a cloth mask that can be washed, reused and is appropriate for school use is required for grades 4-8

1 expanding file folder (accordion)

- Should be no larger than 6 or 7 pockets

1 large pencil pouch, should close with a zipper (at least 8"x5")

Magnetic pencil cup for locker (you will keep your own labeled extra pens/pencils in here)

4 black ballpoint pens – must not bleed through paper

1 red ballpoint pens- must not bleed through paper

12 pencils, sharpened (mechanical or wooden is acceptable)

1 packet of 3" x 5" index cards, ruled (**Only for last names A-M**)

1 package of filler paper, college ruled (**Only for last names N-Z**)

3 dry erase markers, thin tip, black

1 set of 8 slim markers, water based (not permanent ink)

1 set of 12 colored pencils

1 highlighter

1 small scissors

1 small Elmers glue

1 glue stick

1 set of small earbuds that can fit in pencil case with other supplies

2 large boxes of tissues (250+ count)

1 package of baby wipes

2 containers of disinfecting wipes (it's ok if you cannot find this item due to our current circumstances)

1 Refillable, clear, plastic water bottle (please no metal or glass) labeled with your name

Calculator Information for Grades 6-8:

All students in grades 6-8 should use the TI-15 calculator they received in fifth grade. If a student is new to the school or has lost their calculator, they should bring their homeroom teacher a check for \$20, made payable to St. Mary Catholic School, on the first day of school. The school will issue them a

TI-15 calculator to keep and use for the rest of their time at St. Mary. (Any student with a calculator other than a TI-15 will be issued one by the school, and the family will be billed \$20).
