- Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled Mass. Doors will close 5 minutes before Mass begins.
- Please remember masks are required on campus and to keep a safe distance from one another. Use main front doors & door near Admin. Building, all other doors are locked.
- Admin Office is Open Mon Fri 9am 1pm;
- Church is Open Mon Fri 10am 5pm; The Church and bathrooms are cleaned after the 8:30am Mass.



**ISOLATION: THE SILENT DANGER** - (continued): Here, in our own area, we find neighborhoods changing, supportive friends move away and are replaced by younger people who work all day and are involved with their families with no time to reach out to the older residents on their street. Isolation is silent. It creeps up on us gradually, often were unaware that it's even happening.

However, we're not powerless, and if your physical needs are being met, you may want to think about your emotional health, which is just as important. The best way to overcome isolation is to become a caregiver for yourself, as best you can. That might come as a surprise because we don't think of ourselves as our own caregivers, do we? The way to do this is pretty simple: turn your attention to others. Check-in regularly with old friends through phone conversations, video chats, cards, or letters. Refocusing your energies into concern for others can help you turn away from anxiety, and toward connection. Connection is the magic word.

Decades of evidence demonstrate that human connection protects individuals against anxiety and uncertainty. In the company of loved ones, threats become challenges, and painful shocks hurt less. Loneliness, by contrast, is psychologically poisoning. It worsens sleep, deepens depression, and predicts increased mortality rates among older adults. When things get tough, lonely individuals suffer more. They react more intensely to stress, leading to psychological, immune, and cardiovascular issues.

As mentioned earlier, the Shepherd's Center of Oakton-Vienna has been reaching out to area seniors for over 20 years, offering assistance with medical and shopping rides, friendly phone calls and visits to the homebound, help with minor household repairs, day trips to interesting places and their popular Adventures in Learning series along with its quarterly Lunch 'n' Life program. The staff is poised to resume their services to the seniors in our communities once it's safe to do so. Please keep them in mind if you'd like to volunteer (a good example of self-care) or if you're in need of some assistance. It works both ways! Call 703-281-0538.
