You AND your escort are responsible for attending all practices for the introductory dance. If costumes are required, they will be loaned to you by ASB. Otherwise, you will be told what to wear.	You must make, produce and edit your own video. ASB will not do this for you. When turning in your video, it MUST: -Be NO LONGER than 3 minutes. -Be appropriate, yet funny. -Saved to a flash drive or burned to a CD. -Do NOT burn as a DVD file. Save it as the completed file (preferably QuickTime).	You will submit a description of your talent with your application. You will perform your talent for a panel of teachers BEFORE the event to make sure it is appropriate. Students will NOT see your talent – so you can keep it a secret from everyone!	You will need to provide your own swimsuit. During the swimsuit competition a brief biography of you will be read to the audience. You may also pick the song you would like played during your “strut.” Your swimsuit must be appropriate, though it can be creative and funny.	NOTE: We are working on getting eveningwear attire for you at little or no cost. More information on this to come. During the eveningwear portion, you will be accompanied by your escort. At the end of your walk, the hosts will ask you a free-response question. Let your personality shine with your response!
