- New layer 3 switches (routers) will be installed soon.
- New district firewall was installed August 1st to provide greater network security and support future internet bandwidth increases.
- Final contract for new wide area network (Fiber WAN) going to school board for approval Monday night.
- Increase of bandwidth through AT&T is scheduled for September 14th.









- Develop, conceptually, what a 3.0 environment could look like in MISD






Community Engagement Continued

Renovations

- Walkthroughs of current facilities begins September 13th.
