A. Mr. Norris shared the minutes from the June 12, 2018 meeting for review.

III. <u>Project Updates</u>

Mrs. Rola Fadel

• Irvin Rebuild

Ms. Fadel shared that the bid date of Irvin Elementary had been March 1, 2018 with a notice to proceed on March 29 and a substantial completion projected for April 26, 2019.

MHS Athletic Complex

The MHS Athletic Complex shows a bid day of April 4, 2018 with a notice to proceed on April 17 and a substantial completion of February 15, 2019.

• W.G. Roesler Athletic Complex

The W.G. Roseler Athletic Complex had a bid date of September 6, 2018 with an anticipated notice to proceed of September 18 and a substantial completion date of June 25, 2019.

Middle School #3

Middle School #3 has a projected bid date of October 3 with an anticipated notice to proceed of October 16 and a substantial completion date of May 15, 2020.

• Existing Campus Renovations & Refresh

The existing campus renovations and refresh included items such as: paint refresh, flexible furnishing for classrooms, writable surfaces in the hallways, collaborative areas, some locker removal and tile replacement.

NOTE: The serving line in the kitchen at Frank Seale Middle School was redesigned over the summer of 2018.

Middle School competition fields with the added stands and concession stand areas are nearing completion at Frank Seale Middle School and Walnut Grove.

IV. Financial Report

Mr. Jim Norris

- Projects as of August 31, 2018
- Debt Repayment & Management Strategy

Mr. Norris shared that in August of 2018 the Board approved an Order to Defease and Call 2013-C Bonds which allowed \$1,400,000 in future bond payments to be paid early and \$1,792,000 in savings for MISD taxpayers. Over the past few years, Midlothian ISD and BOK Financial Services have identified and implemented the following debt management strategies to reduce the cost of voter approved bonds by \$48.9M!

- 10 Bond Refunding Programs at a Lower Interest Rate = \$27,201,090
- 4 Prepayment of Bonds Prior to Scheduled Maturity = \$7,667,975
- 3 Incorporated Variable Rate Bonds Strategically to Lower Interest Payments = \$13,993,888
- Total Savings to MISD Taxpayers = \$48,862,953
