

Debt Repayment Strategy

August 20, 2018

School Board approved an Order to Defease and Call 2013-C Bonds

- \$1,400,000 in future bond payments to be paid early
- \$1,792,000 in savings for MISD taxpayers



Debt Management Strategy

- Working as partners with our financial advisors, BOK Financial Services, past and present MISD School Board and Administrators have purposely and diligently worked to reduce the borrowing costs for MISD Bond issues.
- Over the past few years, Midlothian ISD and BOK Financial Services have identified and implemented the following debt management strategies to reduce the cost of voter approved bonds by \$48.9M!



Debt Management Strategy

- 10 Bond Refunding Programs at a Lower Interest Rate = \$27,201,090
- 4 Prepayment of Bonds Prior to Scheduled Maturity = \$7,667,975
- 3 Incorporated Variable Rate Bonds Strategically to Lower Interest Payments = \$13,993,888

Total Savings to MISD Taxpayers = \$48,862,953


