Curry College requires Certification of Financial Resources from all applicants who are not United States Citizens or who do not have permanent resident visas at the time of admissions. This form MUST be completed as part of the visa application process. The I-20 CANNOT be issued, per USCIS law, until this certification is received by the Curry College Admission Office. **Also, an official bank statement/or official letter from the bank signed by a bank official dated within the last six months and show the dates (photocopies can be used if legible). Can be in any currency but it must convert into at least the US Dollar amount owed and must clearly state which currency it is in. The statement must consist of an actual amount not "sufficient funds". If the student is using a sponsor the bank statement must be accompanied by a letter from the bank account holder confirming that the funds can be used by the student.**
