First, I want to congratulate you and your children on the completion of what has been quite a year! Never before has it been more essential for us to partner with you in the learning process. On behalf of all our teachers, I want to thank you for the amount of time, energy, attention, and patience you provided to your children and to us day in and day out. We simply could not have delivered a successful distance learning program without your help. I understand how exhausting and disruptive this process has been for you and our entire family and we deeply appreciate the critical part you played in the many successes we have achieved with your children.

Before we enjoy a bit of summer vacation, I would like to invite you to join a Virtual Town Hall on Wednesday, June 17 at 7:00 pm. During the meeting, I will be addressing several questions that I have received over the last few weeks and you will be able to ask questions through the chat feature. Jim Heus, our incoming Interim Head of School, will be joining the meeting and you will be able to hear from him as well. Over the past six weeks, I have been working with Jim to update him on our current activities and to involve him in our planning process.

Our Re-Entry Task Force has been meeting weekly since early May. Our goal is to resume classes on campus in the fall with the health and safety of our students and faculty a primary focus. We know that returning to campus significantly enhances our academic program and also provides the social and emotional support we all need.

The Task Force is waiting for additional guidelines from the State of Connecticut. Nonetheless using the guidelines that are available today, we are currently planning three scenarios for the fall academic program:

- Scenario A: On campus learning with safety precautions. A distance learning option will be available to students who cannot return to campus
- Scenario B: 50/50 Option with half the students on campus and the other half in distance learning on a rotating basis
- Scenario C: Full distance learning which would only occur if mandated by the State of Connecticut or a quarantine period is required

In each of these scenarios, there are many variables to consider in planning. Attached you will find additional information which provides you with a summary of feedback from the recent parent survey as well as a matrix outline of our present re-entry plan. These plans are likely to be adjusted after we receive further guidelines from the State, which are expected on or around June 20.

As we work through the summer, we will continue to update you with the weekly newsletter and plan on hosting live update meetings every two weeks.
