

MIDDLE SCHOOL LEARNING LAB DESCRIPTION AND APPLICATION

The mission of the TCA Middle School Learning Lab is to guide and encourage students in discovering the value of the gifts with which God has blessed them. We strive to equip each student with the tools to be on an “even academic playing field” with their peers and the confidence to reach their ultimate potential while taking ownership of responsibility for their personal success.

Learning Lab students come to the Learning Lab during their grade level assigned PASTime each day. Learning Lab teachers meet with the students and review grades and missing or low work in addition to providing curriculum support according to individual needs. The students come to the Learning Lab for every test and are allowed extended time, usually time and a half, for each test. Learning Lab teachers facilitate communication between the student, parents, and teachers to provide the needed support.

For admission to Learning Lab:

- Complete the application.
- Provide a current copy (within the last three years) of a full battery of psychoeducational testing, including IQ and achievement testing which states a diagnosis of either a learning difference and/or ADHD.
- Bring, send or email the application and testing to the Middle School Learning Lab *To the attention of Suzy Gooch; sgooch@trinitychristian.org.*
- The information will be reviewed.
- If a student meets the qualifications and a space is available at that time, the student will be admitted to Learning Lab.
- If space is unavailable at the time of application, the student will be placed on a grade level waiting list.
