Instructions as Required by ReOpen CT, Governor Lamont:

Parents are required to complete a health screening daily for each child in the household who is attending school. Please complete the Health Screening each morning before your child leaves for school. Parents are required to send the completed Health Screening form in to school with your child each day. Your child will have his/her temperature taken when he/she arrives to school each day to verify that he/she does not have a temperature higher than 100 degrees Fahrenheit. If your child has a temperature greater than 100 degrees Fahrenheit, the parent/guardian will be called to come to school to pick up the child and he/she will be required to bring in a note from a healthcare provider or a negative COVID-19 test in order to return.

Please note, if your child had a fever overnight or in the morning, please DO NOT give him/her Tylenol/Motrin and then SEND HIM/HER TO SCHOOL! If he/she has had a fever prior to the start of school please keep him/her home to prevent the spread of germs.
