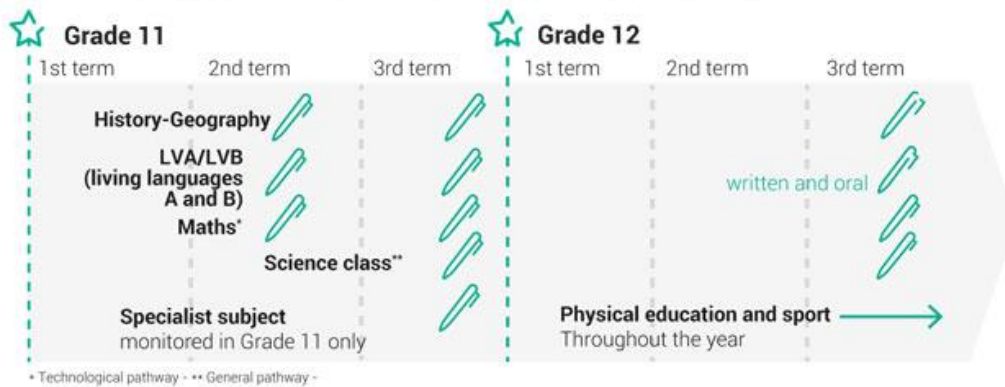


# Baccalauréat 2021: exam timetable and duration
