



Cell Phone/Electronic Devices Agreement

Expectations:

- ✓ Participants in The PULSE program are welcome to bring cell phones and other electronic devices daily.
- ✓ There will be times throughout the day that cell phones/devices will need to be put away- these times will be communicated by The PULSE staff
- ✓ Cell Phones/Electronic Devices may not be used to access media that includes inappropriate language, songs, pictures or jokes including swearing, teasing, references to drugs/alcohol, abuse, racism, gender, bias, sexual material, etc.
- ✓ Students will not be allowed to play any server games (ex. Minecraft) during the Pulse.

Enforcement Steps:

First Offense: The device will be confiscated for the remainder of the day and the parent/guardian will be notified of the incident. The student will pick the device up from The PULSE staff at the end of the day.

Second Offense: The device will be confiscated for the remainder of the day. The device may be picked up from The PULSE staff at the end of that day but only by the student's parent/guardian. In addition, the student may be required to participate in an individual or small group discussion facilitated by The PULSE staff (and any individuals affected by the violation).

Third Offense: The device will be confiscated for the remainder of the day and must be picked up by the student's parents. The student will not be allowed to bring cell phones/electronic devices when attending The PULSE.
