

Widefield Parks and Recreation Adult Softball Covid-19 Guidelines

- Groups of 25 or less practicing or playing on the field at one time.
- Players are encouraged to maintain social distance when possible.
- Spectators are discouraged from attending. If spectators choose to attend, they must maintain social distance.
- Players & spectators should exit the facility as quickly as possible following the end of their game.
- Masks for participants are required upon entering and exiting the facility. During game play and physical exertion, masks are not required.
- Masks are encouraged for spectators and Widefield Parks & Recreation staff.
- Players are encouraged to bring their own snacks and beverages.
- Players are encouraged to use their own personal athletic equipment and not share.
- The catcher will stand 6 feet behind the batter, behind the designated "Catcher line".
- Base coaches will also be required to stand 6 feet from the players on the field.
- Balls will be given to each team separately to use for the entire game. When the game concludes, those balls will be given to the Site Supervisor to sanitize and clean.
- If anyone is exhibiting symptoms of cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, or diarrhea, they should not attend games.
