

Dual Curriculum Path

Middle School Program
Grades 6 to 8

- Imminent preparation for high school
- Advanced curriculum: Algebra I, Spanish I, Science, Social Studies
- Continuation of Advisor/Advisee program
- Exploratory class designed challenge students in areas of interest

Intermediate Grade Program
Grades 4 and 5

Blending of Primary and Junior Level Montessori

- Introduction of Advisor/Advisee program
- Form strong study, organizational, and time management skills
- Collaborative learning opportunities

Junior Level Montessori Program
Ages 6 to 8

- Teacher as “facilitator”
- Three multi-age classrooms
- Weekly student plans; begins use of textbooks
- Culture curriculum extended to social studies, science

Primary Program
Grades 1 to 3

- Teacher as “director”
- Age-specific classrooms
- Learning units, multiple textbooks
- Projects in social studies and experiments in science

Montessori Preschool Program
Ages 3 to 5

- Teacher as “facilitator”
- Three multi-age classrooms
- American Montessori Society (AMS)-certified teachers
- Students have same teacher for three consecutive years
- Student sets own learning pace
- Prepared environment



Pre-Primary and Kindergarten Program
Ages 3 to 5

- Teacher as “director”
- Age-specific classrooms
- State-certified teachers
- Teacher “loops” - stays with children for two-year cycle before Kindergarten
- Individual, small group and whole group instruction
- Thematic approach with learning centers
