All persons driving on District business will: (1) follow the most direct route; (2) avoid all unnecessary stops; (3) not carry unauthorized non-District personnel or students or guests as passengers; (4) not carry more that 7 students, no matter what size of vehicle, (5) ensure that all vehicle occupants use seat belts if available in the vehicle, and (6) the minimum age of any driver shall not be less than twenty-one (21) years of age. In addition, all employees and volunteers of the district will be cleared through the Megan's Law database and the Department of Justice.
