Headmaster's Introduction

It is my pleasure to welcome you all to Felsted's first virtual Speech Day. In the previous 455 years, this is not the first time that Felsted has had to close its doors, with a polio outbreak being mentioned in the history as requiring work to be gathered for all the boys, and sent to their homes for them to continue their learning. Another form of remote learning took place throughout the Second World War, with the school evacuated just over 150 miles West of Essex, to Goodrich Court in Herefordshire for the duration of the conflict. Remote learning in the 21st century is a little different to that, with google meets, chromebooks and kahoot.

Apart from the fact that we are delivering this Speech Day virtually, there are also other changes today. First, we are combining Prep and Senior, to celebrate across the whole Felsted Community. Second, our prizes have changed in two key ways: we are awarding prizes that will reward those who have displayed true Felsted Characteristics, rather than these being just subject based; also, we have deliberately limited individuals to one academic prize, so that we can recognise more of our students. These are changes that we will look to continue into the future.

I am very sorry that we cannot welcome you on site, and share our hospitality with you today, but I hope that you will be making an effort to mark this special day with us. Please do send us your pictures via social media (#Felsted2020), so that we can see what you are doing to celebrate a year that will live long in the memory.

I would like to pass on my thanks to all the Felsted staff, who have kept the school running remotely, and the site running throughout strange times. I would also like to thank the Governors for their work, and all of the parents for your support and encouragement. I fully understand that this has not been an easy time for many of you, and the changes that we have had to make have often been done at short notice. It really does make a difference to get positive messages, and I am very grateful for those.

Finally, more than any other year, I would like to thank the pupils. It has been more obvious than ever that a school is not about buildings, but about pupils, and without the children here, it has been a lonely place. What has kept us all going is to see the wonderful work that has been done, and the number of pupils who have gone out of their way to do things for others, to challenge themselves, and to make sure that they can answer the question of what they did during the lockdown with confidence and assurance. Have a wonderful summer, and we look forward to seeing you all back in September.

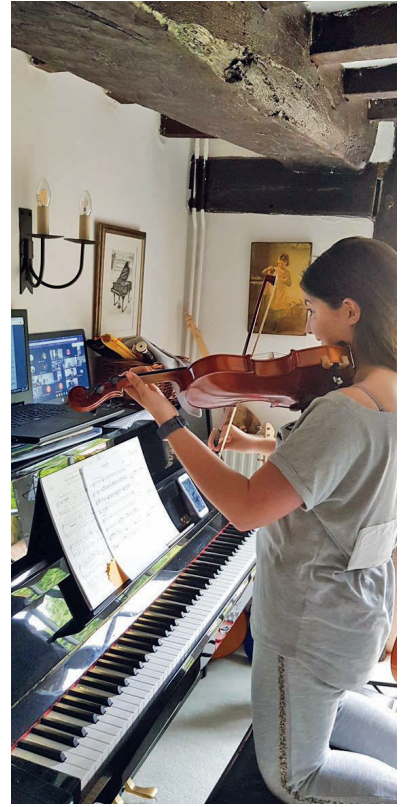
