

The adversity created by COVID-19 can't keep the St. Michael's College School alumni community of entrepreneurs from rising above.

Luke de Haas '15 is a founding member of Mosea, a Toronto-based mobile crowd-funding platform startup that simplifies group money transfers and ticket sales. With social distancing measures pausing all large-scale gatherings, including concerts and sporting events, de Haas and colleagues have pivoted Mosea technology to help local food banks.



On May 19, 2020, they kicked off [Mosea Meals](#), a fundraiser to support hunger-relief efforts of the charitable organization Daily Bread Food Bank. Daily Bread provides food support to more than 130 member agency food banks and homemade meals to agencies that operate shelters or drop-in programs across the Greater Toronto Area.

"We recognized that we had resources and a strong network of support at our disposal to make a positive impact on our community," says de Haas. "We hope Mosea Meals can help the Daily Bread Food Bank relieve some stress among our more vulnerable community members during this difficult time."
