

ARE YOU REALLY READY TO RETIRE? – You'll know if you have answers to these questions. Retirement can be surprisingly stressful. You're trading the familiarity and stimulation of a job for an unstructured life of redefinition. But the more you plan your transition, the easier it will be. So, ask yourself these questions, based on ones that psychotherapist Tessa Albert Warschaw devised. They'll help you judge how prepared you are.

- What will you miss from work? The challenges? The social life? Your authority?
- Will not working make you feel less vital?
- Do you have an agenda for filling your time with your choice of hobbies and interests?
- What will make you rise each day as excited as you were at the high points of your career?
- What ambitions are you waiting to fulfill?
- How do you think you being around the home more will affect your spouse, if you have one? What does your spouse think?
- To what extent will you be in service to other family members once you retire? How do you feel about that?

If you have answers to all these questions, that's great. But if any stump you, start reflecting on them. They'll probably raise more questions for you. And that's good. The more answers you have, the more ready you'll be to retire well. (Adapted from an article by Jeri Sedlar and Rick Miners in the AARP Bulletin.)

FRAUD INTERNATIONAL – This topic was the cover story of the AARP Bulletin last month. There was a lengthy article about the origins of various frauds, and the bottom line is that fraud is vast, organized, sophisticated, businesslike, global, and growing. I've often wondered where the hotbeds of fraud were and was surprised at what I learned from the article. Since seniors are prime targets of scammers, I think you might find it interesting. The current centers of fraud activity are located in:

INDIA: Because telemarketing and call centers are a big industry here, a large number of workers have built up their English skills and learned how to charm and empathize with Americans. By day some may be providing bona fide telemarketing, and by night they become techsupport scammers. Many of the scam attempts I've received come from this country, based on the accents of the caller, and usually revolve around non-existent computer issues.

JAMAICA: U.S. and Canadian call centers for legitimate businesses provide a base of customer service training, as does the hotel and resort industry. Young people in poverty are drawn to fraud because they see the scammers living in mansions and driving fancy cars. Julie Getz, the executive producer of AARP's The Perfect Scam podcast, says, "When schoolchildren are asked what they want to be when they grow up, the number one answer is Jamaican track star Usin Bolt. Number two is a scammer."

<u>COSTA RICA</u>: Scam businesses are prevalent in part because it's difficult to extradite Costa Rican citizens. Costa Rican operations hire young Jamaicans to work there but fail to tell them that they aren't protected because they don't have Costa Rican citizenship.

ROMANIA/EASTERN EUROPE: Specialists in high-tech scams often hail from Eastern Europe. Frauds include ATM skimming – installing a device that scans information from your card while a camera captures your PIN. In 2017 U.S. prosecutors indicted the mostly Romanian members of a criminal organization called the Hornea Crew on charges of running a skimming conspiracy in seven states.

NIGERIA: This is home to "romance scammers," who find victims on dating sites or social media. They even create profiles of themselves using stolen photos of attractive people, a practice called "catfishing." The scammers convince victims they have found true love – then ask for money for plane fare or medical bills. I've also gotten a number of non-romance e-mails from scammers in this country, telling me I've been chosen to receive an enormous amount of money (for whatever reason) once I give them my banking information.

FLORIDA: The Miami and Tampa areas have long been recognized as incubators for Medicare fraud. One of the biggest recent cases involved a scheme in which a South Florida company called Lotus Health would convince older people that they needed genetic tests for cancer. Medicare would then pay the labs that ordered the tests; the labs, in turn, paid kickbacks to the scammers. As a bonus, the scammers got people's Medicare numbers, which could be sold on the black market. Next week you'll read about the six scams to dodge this year. Be sure to read the AARP article in its entirety if you haven't already.
