

Seven Deadly Sins, Seven Lively Virtues Tuesdays Feb 25th -**April 7th** During the Season of Lent, our Tuesday Scripture Study will be exploring Seven Deadly Sins, Seven Lively Virtues. Join Bishop Robert Barron for this presentation of the seven deadly sins, those great spiritual blocks that inhibit our flourishing in relationship with God and one another. 
