We will follow Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) and the OCS's policies and guidance on response. Should we as a school, CCF or Church be instructed by the FCHD, FCPS and/or OCS to implement any pandemic response, we would notify parents/guardians immediately. Please be assured that we already have a Pandemic Response Policy ready to implement should the need arise.

We are asking for parents/guardians, faculty and staff to please notify the our offices of past and future travel plans in an effort to continue to keep communities healthy.

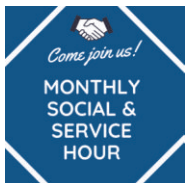
The best source of information is directly from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) [www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html](http://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html) and the FCHD website [www.fairfaxcounty.gov/health/novel-coronavirus](http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/health/novel-coronavirus).

All are asked to stay home with a fever (100.4F or higher) for at least 24 hours after the last fever. All must be fever-free without using the medicine for a full 24 hours before trying to activities. A fever is the body's way of communicating it is fighting an infection (virus or bacteria), and it needs time to heal and fight the infection.

As always, you are reminded to use common sense in the reception of Holy Communion from the Cup. If you are feeling ill, think you may have been exposed to a virus, or do not feel comfortable receiving from the Cup you should refrain from partaking of the Blood of Christ from the Cup. In the same way, you should refrain from offering your hand to others at the sign of peace. A smile and a heartfelt "Peace be with you" should suffice.

The obligation to attend Sunday Mass does not apply to those who are ill, who suffer from contagious disease or are in comprised health. If you are homebound and want to receive communion please contact [liturgy@olgcv.org](mailto:liturgy@olgcv.org). Please see information on page 13 regarding televised Mass.

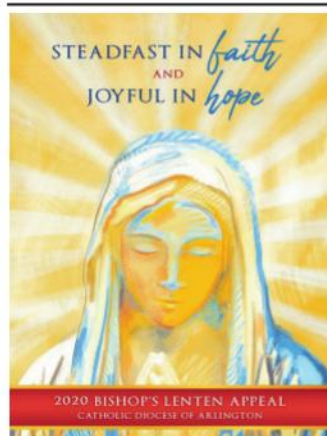

**AGING IN PLACE – MOVE # 2: GO SLOW** – It might seem intimidating to look around a large house with multiple bedrooms, stairs, and levels, and wonder how you can ever make it age-friendly. But you don’t have to do everything at once. Tackle projects in increments and you can gradually create a safe and livable space, says Sarah Susanka, an architect and author of “The Not So Big House” series. “No matter what your income bracket, you have a lot more options than you may realize,” she says. “You can take almost any house, and with a little bit of modifications, make it work.”

Transform a main level screened porch or office into a future bedroom, and remodel a powder room into a full bath, and you’ve got one-floor living space, for example. Retain your remaining upstairs bedrooms to eventually house full-time, live-in caregivers, which is something many older adults fail to consider in their plans.

Simple things such as taping down throw rugs won’t cost you much, and other improvements don’t have to break your budget. Widening a doorway typically runs about \$600-\$1,000. For her parents’ house, Susanka bought two \$99 ramps on Amazon to install at two separate sets of small steps within the home, and she bought a \$150 ramp to allow access for a wheelchair from the inside to the backyard terrace. “It’s all they needed for now,” she says.

If you feel overwhelmed, schedule a meeting with an architect familiar with aging in place. Susanka says there are many architects who will make a house call for just an hourly consultation fee for ideas on improvements. She’s compiled a searchable list at [www.susanka.com/home-professionals-directory](http://www.susanka.com/home-professionals-directory).

But don’t wait too long to start, so that you can still have a say in your renovation preferences. Susanka says she learned this from experience; her father, an engineer in his nineties, can no longer draw any of his remodeling ideas, although he knows exactly what he wants.

Stephen Grant, 78, a retired Foreign Service officer living in Arlington, VA., began to worry about his future because he has foot neuropathy, which he expects will limit his mobility as he ages. But he wants to remain in his longtime Dutch Colonial home. After meeting with a local aging-in-place specialist, he had a wheelchair-accessible external ramp built on two sides of his house next to his driveway, kitchen, and garage about three years ago. For now, his adult children and their kids use it to roll up their suitcases during holiday visits. But Grant says he believes it will be useful to him someday. “I built it well in advance of when I’ll need it, but for me, it’s peace of mind,” he says. (Next week: Move #3: Figure Out Your Finances. (Thanks to Kiplinger’s Retirement Report.)
