- The weekday Masses have been very light in attendance, so if you are hesitant to come back, attending a 8:30am weekday Mass might be the best way to try it out.
- Sign up at least one day prior to your Mass time. The schedule for the following week will be added on Thursdays.
- If you have trouble with the sign up, please call the office 703.938.2828 or email <u>communications@olgcva.org</u>.
- Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled Mass. Doors will close 5 minutes before Mass begins.
- Please remember masks are required on campus and to keep a safe distance from one another. Use main front doors & door near Admin. Building, all other doors are locked.
- If after you sign up for Mass, you are unable to attend, please remove yourself from the signup, so that your space can be used for someone else. We use the numbers as a count for distribution of Communion.
- Church is Open Mon Fri 10am 5pm; The Church and bathrooms are cleaned after the 8:30am Mass.
- Church is closed on Saturdays & Sundays except for Mass, in order to be prepared for Mass and to clean in between the Masses.
- Chapel remains closed during this time.
- Confessions will be on Saturdays after the 8:30am Mass until 9:30am.
