

On Campus: Health Protocols

Screenings: We may be conducting daily screenings for our faculty, staff, and students. These screenings may include questionnaires and temperature monitoring.

We ask that you check your student's temperature every morning before coming to school. If there is a temperature over 100° F (37.8° C), do not come to school. No student should take a medicine with a fever-reducer before coming to school.

Masks: In consultation with the many organizations identified on page 4 of this plan, face coverings are strongly believed to reduce the spread of COVID-19. St. Mark's is currently evaluating the ideal implementation of mask use for students and faculty. This includes, but is not limited to, when and where they should be worn and who is required to wear them.
