The position

Tilton School seeks an energetic teacher in Digital Art. Successful candidates will possess a background in design and advanced experience in photography, video, and/or graphic arts. Candidates should demonstrate an ability to connect with kids, engage them in skill development, and instill in them a passion for using art to make meaningful differences in people's lives.

Preference will be given to candidates who have

- Experience as a practicing artist in digital media, graphic arts, animation, digital storytelling and/or video;
- A strong commitment to promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion;
- A genuine desire to work with high school students;
- Outstanding communication skills;
- Experience with or willingness to learn about backward curriculum-design and standards-based assessment.

Other duties include

- Advising a small group of students or assisting with an established advisory group;
- Participating as an athletic coach or activities leader for two seasons each year;
- Serving within the Residential Life program, typically involving after-school, weeknight and weekend duties.
