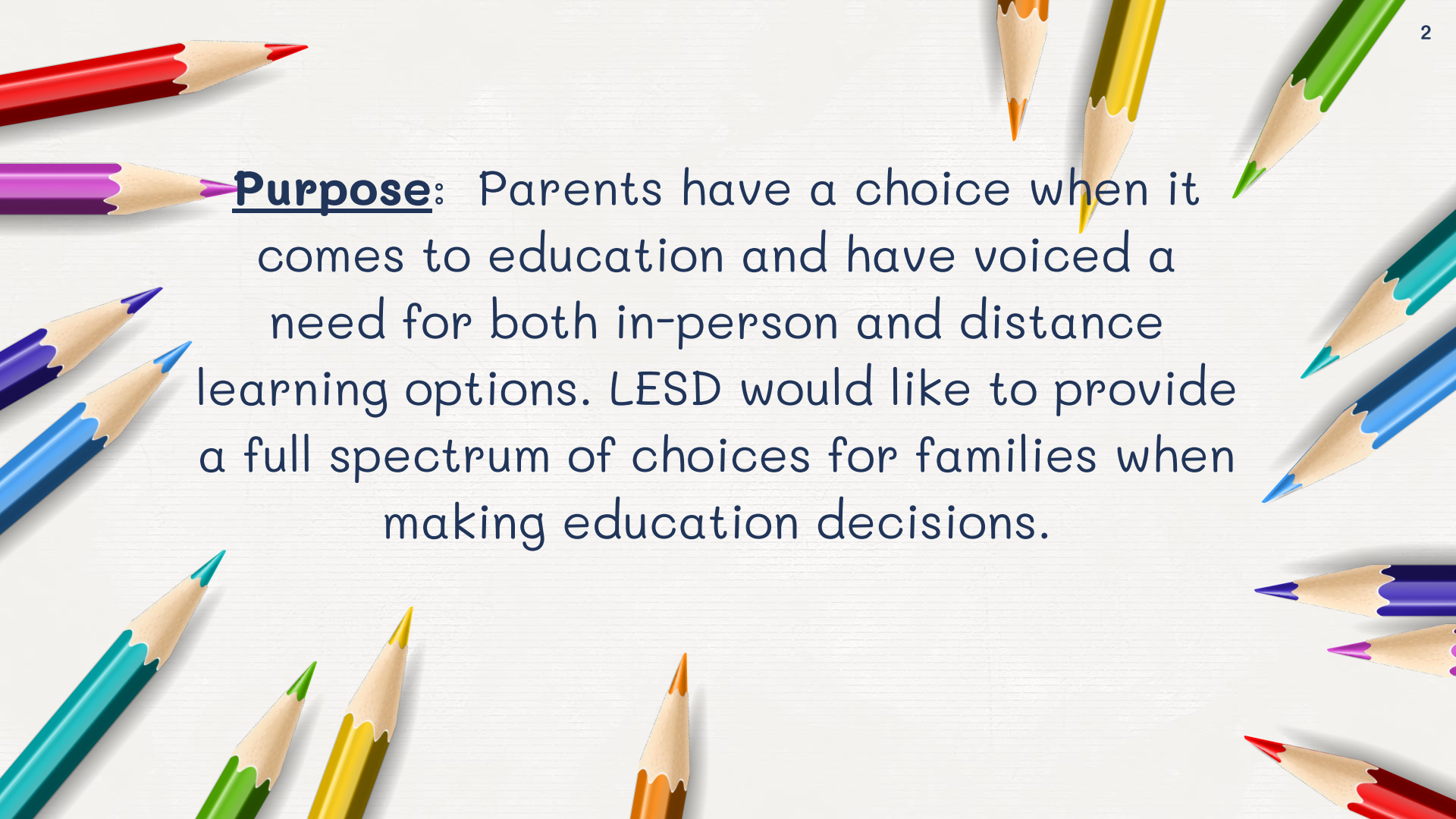

LESD Digital Learning Academy Overview

Full-time virtual teaching/learning school - Live teacher-led instruction (recordings made available after live lessons) and asynchronous learning. This model will support grades K-8. Students may choose to transition to in-person learning at intervals if space is available.

- ✘ 5 full days per week of instruction using best practices for online learning, SEL, intervention and additional support.
- ✘ Content designed and delivered from LESD teachers and curriculum.

 - Small group instruction
 - 1:1 support
 - Accommodations and support services provided
