- LE classrooms run the annual Baby Basics Program, students collect and organize the donated items for Children's Aid and Family Services.

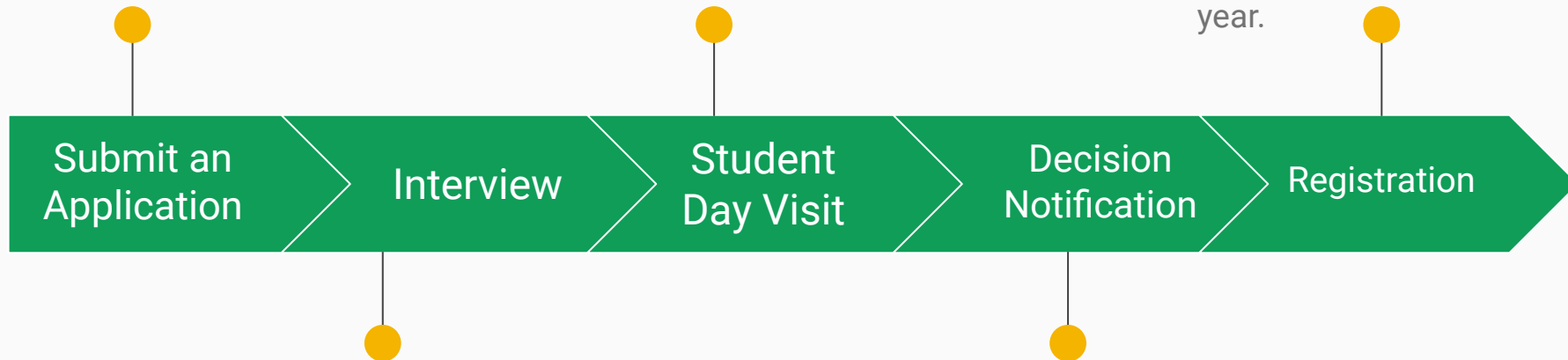
