



WHITEHEAD UNIFORM POLICY

The staff and parents of Whitehead support a mandatory uniform policy to be followed by all Whitehead students. It is our belief that safety, modesty, simplicity, good taste, and cleanliness are important in promoting optimal learning and also in minimizing distractions.

Tops:

- ✓ Any solid color (no logos) polo shirt or blouse with collar
- ✓ long sleeve polo shirt or turtleneck in any solid color
- ✓ button or pullover sweater in navy blue, white, or gray
- ✓ Whitehead sweatshirts, plain sweatshirts, or sweaters in school colors may be worn any day of the week with a uniform polo or plain turtleneck in any solid color worn underneath in cooler weather (hoods are allowed as long as they are a solid uniform color with NO logos)

Bottoms:

***Belts are encouraged.

- ✓ navy blue, gray, black, or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers
- ✓ shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be long enough so that fingertips reach the bottom of the garment when student is standing
- ✓ No leggings may be worn as pants alone, they must be accompanied by a skirt or dress

Footwear:

- ✓ shoes that enclose foot with no heels
- ✓ no “heelys” or skate shoes
- ✓ choice of socks, tights, or leggings
- ✓ separate gym shoes with laces (velcro for kindergarten)

Students may wear **denim jeans** and **Whitehead Spirit wear** or club shirts on the last day of every week.

In addition to the Whitehead uniform policy, Whitehead students must adhere to the Rockford Public School District 205 dress code policy as outlined in the elementary handbook.
