



2020-2021 Servite Textbook Instructions

Servite strives to provide its students with the best possible resources to help them be successful in each of their classes. Part of the technology fee is used to order electronic versions of textbooks.

To obtain other textbooks, you will need your son's schedule to identify his course ID numbers and course titles. His preliminary course requests will be listed in Aeries in early July 2020.

1. Review the 2020-2021 Textbook List found on the Servite website.
2. Carefully review the information in the "Purchase Requirement" column of the textbook list; this field provides specific requirements and instructions for each textbook. See below for more information.

Purchase Requirement Instructions

New: These courses require the purchase of a new textbook/workbook.

New or Used: These courses will be using textbooks that are already in print. You may purchase new or used textbooks from the publisher, Amazon, or other online retailers.

Note: Some retailers offer textbook rental options. *Rented books will have to be returned according to the retailer's instructions. **Servite is not responsible for any rented books that are lost or stolen.**

Optional: This course will use a digital textbook with access provided by Servite High School. The cost of digital textbooks (Optional Purchase) is included in the Servite technology fee. Digital textbook access information will be provided by the teacher. Families have the option to purchase a print edition of the textbook to use in conjunction with the e-text Servite provides.

See Teacher/Teacher Provides Resources: The teacher will provide information about classroom curriculum for the course. **DO NOT PURCHASE ANY CURRICULUM.**

Course Fee: For the majority of courses, the technology fee covers the cost of the e-text, but in the case of some specialized courses (HP/AP and electives) an electronic version is not available or Servite was able to purchase course workbooks at a reduced rate by ordering in bulk passing on the savings and ordering convenience to the parents. The business office processes all supplemental workbook/course fees and will add charges to students' accounts.
