



**A: Ice Age National Scenic Trail** - 1.27 miles  
Part of the almost 1200 mile IANST in WI  
Very well marked; Distance within the arboretum

**B: JSOL Main Trail** - 0.93 miles  
Wide Gravel & grass. Part of outer loop

---

**C: JSOL Primary Nature Educational Trail** - 0.30 miles  
Wide with educational markers

---

**D: JSOL Upper Trail** - 1.00 miles  
Well marked dirt single track in the woods

**E: JSOL Lower Trail** - 0.88 miles  
Original "LOWER" trail starts at parking lot 1

---

**F: JSOL Orange Trail** - 0.79 miles  
Old trail with higher up markers (arrows show markers)

**G: JSOL Paved Cabin Trail** - 0.29 miles  
wide and paved access to historic cabin. Part of outer loop

---

**H: JSOL East Boundary Powerline Trail** - 0.84 miles  
Wide, grassy, and hilly under powerlines and near the road portion of Arbor Ridge Way. Part of outer loop

---

**I: JSOL Three Mile (Marsh) Creek Trail** - 0.75 miles  
Crosses the creek at bridge; can be WET by marsh

---

**J: JSOL Ironwoods Trail** - 0.54 miles  
Dirt single track winding inside hardwood forest

---

**K: JSOL Cross Country Ski Trail** - 0.47 miles  
Mostly wide - some climb




---

**L: East West Short Cut Trail** - 0.23 miles  
Dirt single track cutting from Main trail to East Boundary Trail

---

**M: Dry Creek Bed:** This will run with water after heavy rain
