EL Continuous Learning

For Students Who Opt to Stay Home

Whether students are on campus or at home, our continuous learning plan will allow students to create relationships and build community with their peers and teachers through synchronous participation in classroom activities, as well as individual and small group check ins. Utilizing both web-based video cameras, as well as interactive technology, the classroom teams will create robust academic and SEL learning experiences for all students - whether they are at school or at home.

A sample of the activities included in the Continuous Learning day:

- Synchronous morning meeting with classroom peers
- Morning instructional time, via video feed from the classroom, small group work with a teacher or an individual check in from the teacher
- Independent work time
- Lunch via Zoom with peers
- Afternoon instructional time, via video feed from the classroom, small group work with a teacher or an individual check in from the teacher
- Independent work time
- Participation in end of day story, meeting, or reflection with the class

Each day will include options for Specialist check-ins, both synchronously and asynchronously. Learning Support will also be available for students through either small group check ins or individually.
