### <u>Bible</u>

- 1" three-ring binder
- Pens (color does not matter), pencils, highlighter
- Inexpensive earbuds (headphones)

## <u>English</u>

- 1" three-ring binder
- Wide-ruled notebook paper
- Zip pouch (can get one for all subjects)
- Five (5) dividers with tabs or pockets
- Red pens, blue or black ink pens, mechanical pencils, highlighter
- Folder with brads and pockets

## <u>History</u>

- 1" three-ring binder or notes can be on iPad instead
- Red pen & a blue/black pen
- One (1) blank hardback journal (very durable)
- Notecards

# <u>Math (Pre-Algebra)</u>

- Binder or sturdy folder with pockets on both sides and brads in the middle
- Loose-leaf paper
- Red pens & Expo markers
- Mechanical pencils

## Math (Math Team)

- Binder or sturdy folder with pockets on both sides and brads in the middle
- Loose leaf paper
- Graph paper (if you don't use Notability)
- Mechanical pencils
- 3x5 index cards if you want to make "old fashioned" flashcards

# Math (Accelerated Math)

- Spiral Notebook
- 1 folder with brads and/or pockets
- Pencil pouch, pencils, red pen, colored pencils
- Scissors
- Scotch Tape
- Expo Markers (plenty of these)
- 1" binder with loose-leaf paper & graph paper

- Three (3) dividers (for notes, handouts, functions)
- Calculator: TI-30XIIS

#### **Science**

- 2" binder (with a clear cover) can be shared with another subject
- Red pens, #2 mechanical pencils with extra lead, and expo markers
- Inexpensive calculator with square root function-you can use the same calculator that you use in math
- Clear ruler for graphing

#### STEM

• Spiral notebook

#### <u>Spanish 1</u>

- Folder with pockets and brads
- Wide ruled notebook paper
- 2 Dry erase markers (different colors)
- 3 x 5 Index cards (for flash cards if you prefer)
