Message from the Superintendent

Dear Parents,

The triangular relationship between parents, student and school is critical in the education of our students.

In each section of the school we try to ensure that you are kept close to the philosophy of the school, the programmes in the school, what is happening at ABA and of course how the students are doing in school.

In recent weeks, we have held parent/teacher conferences that have provided an opportunity for a dialogue with teachers on the progress of the students. These complement other means of communication relating to student work and assessments, such as in Managebac or Seesaw. I trust you find this communication useful.

We also aim to offer you the opportunity to better understand what is offered at ABA and why. Recently, the regular parent coffee mornings with the principals were held along with a few workshops of special interest.

A Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Extended Essay and CAS information evening last week was much appreciated by the 40 or so parents who were actively involved in getting to know TOK. Many wondered why they had not been able to study this subject themselves at school.

We see parents and teachers as learners as much as students. As further examples, parents of Kindergarten students were able to explore the philosophy behind learning through play, along with insight into how teachers intentionally provide opportunities for such learning.
