In Person Option

In School 5 Days a Week unless sick



Remote Learning Option

(available by quarter, must choose by 7/20)



I'm Healthy

Student attends classes in person 5 days a week.

I'm Sick or Quarantined

Student transitions temporarily to remote learning until healthy enough to return to school or quarantine completed. This will be asynchronous and synchronous learning via Zoom. There are 360 degree SWIVL cameras in every classroom to help

Full Remote Option

Student opts to learn remotely 5 days a week. This is a quarterly option only. Classes will be a combination of asynchronous and synchronous via Zoom. There are 360 degree SWIVL cameras in every classroom to help capture teaching from anywhere in the room. Remote learning students can participate in all extracurricular activities.

Enhanced Cleaning

- Increased cleaning of high-touch zones will occur throughout the day.
- Nightly cleaning will follow CDC guidelines.
- Additional hand sanitizing stations throughout rooms and halls.
- Students will have increased opportunities for hand washing throughout the day.



Face Coverings

Our goal is to protect each other while keeping the school open. We help protect each other by wearing face coverings.

- We will follow ODE guidelines for wearing face coverings at school.
 Face Masks are strongly recommended for students.
- Faculty will wear face coverings at all times, unless alone in their classroom.
- Face masks, neck gaiters, and face shields are acceptable. Please refrain from wearing masks that are inappropriate to the learning environment.





Entering the Buildings

- Parents are expected to take their child's temperature at home prior to coming to school. If your child is fever and symptom free for 48 hours without medication, he/she may come to school.
- As an additional safety precaution, CHCA has purchased Rapid Screen Access Control Thermometers (RSACT) that will be installed at each door entrance.
- All adults and students will be required to stop at the temperature check stations as they enter the building. If an individual's temperature reading is 100 degrees or over, a message will be sent immediately to the school nurse for further assessment. All adults entering the building will also sign in using the normal protocol.
- Staff will be stationed at the entrances to walk the student(s) with a temperature to the nurse as discreetly as possible.



Volunteers, Visitors, and Guests

We value our parent volunteers, visitors, and guests. However, in order to keep our school open, we must reduce the number of people entering the building at this time.

- Anyone entering the building will be expected to follow ODE guidelines for wearing face coverings and having their temperature taken.
- Volunteers will not be working with students. A limited number of volunteers will be used in the building and must be approved by the building principals.
- If volunteering or visiting, all adults will be required to wear face coverings while in the building to stay consistent with the policy for staff.

Mass Gatherings and Field Trips

- Per ODE guidelines for school reopening, field trips need to be rescheduled or canceled throughout the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year. These events will be reviewed for the second semester.
- Mass gatherings (assemblies, chapels, etc.) must be small group or remote.

Water Bottle Procedure

- All students are asked to provide a personal water bottle marked with their name.
- Drinking fountains will only be used to refill student water bottles.



Cafeteria and Recess

- For first semester, students will eat in the classrooms with their Connection Bell. There will be opportunities to eat in the cafeteria and go outside by rotation.
- Recess will be offered every day for 7/8 grade in stations or rotations.
- Seniors will have off campus privileges for lunch, except on chapel days.



Carpool/Drop-Off/Pick-Up

• Curbside drop-off and pick-up is preferred. Parents who wish to come into the building must wear a face covering and stop at the temperature scanner. Students will be socially distanced during carpool to the best of our ability. See building specific guidelines for face covering procedures.


• Band: Given the size of the band room, we have enough space to allow for social distancing.
