Curriculum & Teachers



The majority of our courses to be offered through Canvas using Haverford curriculum and Haverford teachers.

- Haverford teachers will create these courses this summer and fall.
- Haverford teachers will be assigned to these courses to provide instruction or instructional support to the students enrolled.
- Some electives or courses with low enrollment may use curriculum from Pearson which will be curated and facilitated by Haverford teachers.
- Available course list will be published once established.
- Our priority for live interactions will be for our youngest children and students with the most significant needs.
- Depending on enrollment and staffing, schedules will look different at each level.
- A Haverford teacher will be associated with each course.
- Students will engage in these courses as a cohort with Haverford peers.

Parent/Guardian Online Expectations - Elementary

In grades K–5, students require a lot of support from caring adults at home and in the online classroom. Parents or guardians of elementary students in the online program will provide the structure a student needs by establishing and managing the daily routine. Parents/guardians are often thought of as a learning coach at this level.

Parents/Guardians of elementary students can expect to:

- Devote about one hour per day per subject overseeing their students' schoolwork.
- Monitor students' attendance by requiring 2-4 hours of work per course per week.
- Set the daily schedule with varied activities and breaks.
- Assist with lessons and communicate frequently with the teacher.
- Help monitor student progress and comprehension.

Parent/Guardian Online Expectations - Middle & High School

As students become more independent and responsible in grades 7–12, parents “step back” a bit, and subject-specific teachers “step in” to provide expert online instruction and support in math, language arts, science, social studies, and an array of electives. As they get older, online students start to really take charge of their education—setting goals, working independently, and exploring their future options.

Parents/Guardians can encourage their students’ growing independence as they:

- Monitor students' attendance by requiring between 5 & 10 hours of work *per course per week*.
- Verify that lessons and assignments are completed.
- Communicate with teachers, referring students to teachers for help when needed.

Morning: Math and Science Coursework

Mid-morning: Elective Coursework, Check in with a Haverford Teacher

Afternoon: English Language Arts Coursework, Community Building Activity with Haverford Peers

Mid-afternoon: Social Studies Coursework, Participation in Available Extra-curricular Activity

Early Evening: Completion of any open assignments
