Assessment

No assessment is made of children entering the Kindergarten. Priority is given to the children of Dulwich College staff and DUCKS siblings; thereafter, places are offered from the waiting lists in date order of registration.

Up to 40 places, either full or part-time. Children must attend a minimum of 3 sessions weekly.

Assessment of learning and development

Children entering DUCKS at 3, 4, 5 and 6+ will have an assessment in the form of a taster session to ensure that their learning to date is at a level from which they can take full advantage of the curriculum offered. Priority is given to the children of Dulwich College staff and DUCKS siblings; thereafter, places are offered in order of registration.

Visits

Parents wishing to register for the Infants' School waiting lists will be invited to an Open Morning held on a Saturday during the Michaelmas and Summer terms.

Kindergarten and Infants' School

Starting dates

Children generally start in September each year.

Registration dates

Registration for the Kindergarten and the Infants' School is recommended as early as possible.

Registration forms

In the Kindergarten we ask that parents visit DUCKS and complete a registration form after their visit, to be returned with a non-refundable registration fee of £100.

Offers made

Offers are made from December onwards for entry the following September.

The Governors reserve the right to review fee levels at any time.

Before school care and after school care can be booked on an adhoc basis for an additional charge of £11 per session.

All visitors to DUCKS, including prospective parents, are asked to read our Safeguarding Policy which can be found on the policies page of the DUCKS website.

Deposit

A non-refundable deposit of £1,850 is payable on acceptance of a place at DUCKS. The deposit will be retained in full until the child leaves, when it is refunded less any balance due.

Children in the Nursery Class (3+) are guaranteed a place in the Reception Class provided that the place is accepted by the end of the Michaelmas term. The deposit will not be refunded if the place in Reception is not taken up and notice has not been given by the end of the Michaelmas term.

If the child is withdrawn after acceptance, deposits are not refundable.

Termly Fees

Fee accounts are sent out approximately three weeks before the start of each term.

Payment of Fees

Fees are payable by Direct Debit in full on the day before the first day of term. The College will also accept payment by certain credit/ debit cards in full no later than the day before the first day of each term. There is a facility available through a third party credit provider regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority enabling payment by monthly direct debit instalments.

The College does not accept payments in cash. The fee for a child attending DUCKS for any part of a term must be paid for the whole of that term. The withdrawal of a child requires one full term's notice given in writing to the Head of DUCKS, or one full term's fees in lieu.

The College reserves the right to suspend a child while fees remain unpaid, by giving the parents not less than 2 days' written notice. Parents who have paid fees late or whose fees are overdue may be asked to pay one term's fees as an additional deposit. If necessary, the College will instruct solicitors to recover unpaid fees with interest and all costs incurred will be recoverable in full.

Insurance Schemes

All Infants' School pupils are included in a Personal Accident Insurance Scheme which offers cover for permanent disability resulting from an accident.

This includes dental injury and emergency dental treatment. In addition parents can opt-in to a Pupils' Absence Insurance Scheme (at their own expense) to cover absence through personal illness or injury. Advance Payment of Fees Scheme

The College runs its own scheme for advance payment of school fees. Under this arrangement parents are able to pay a lump sum in advance to purchase credits against future school fees, and receive a discount of the amount of credits purchased. Such sums can be paid prior to entry (once a child has been offered a place), on entry, or at any time during a child's time at DUCKS.
